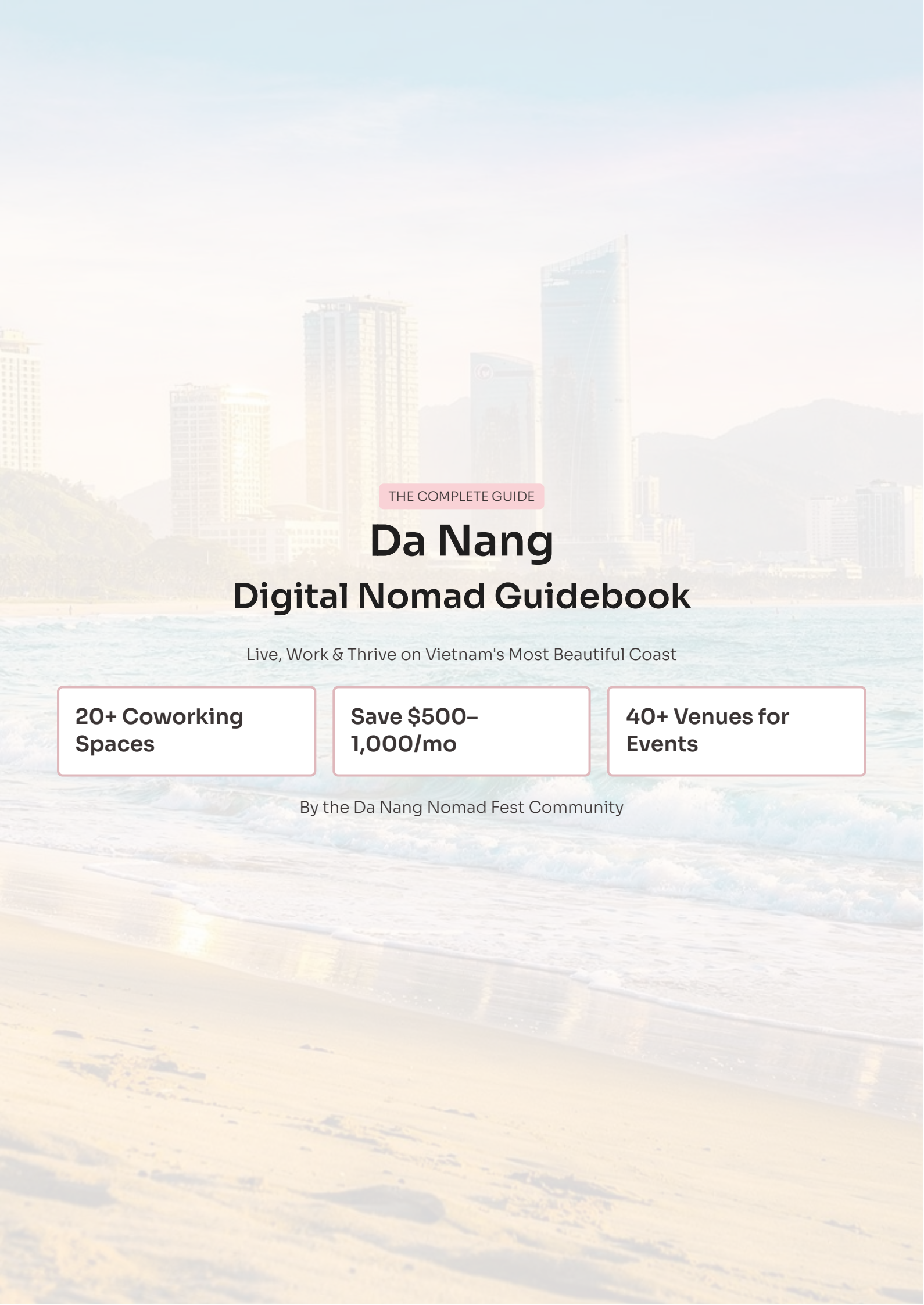

Most Digital Nomads overpay and waste a lot of time and energy simply because they don't know local alternatives. This guide shows you how to live like a local, immediately, helping you skip the expensive learning curve and start living comfortably in Da Nang from day one.

90-day eVisa & Bus Visa Run to Laos

Most passports need an eVisa to enter Vietnam. The eVisa is usually valid for 90 days, with single or multiple entries. Some passports are visa-free, but usually for only 45 days, so people who want to stay longer apply for a 90-day eVisa, too. Approximate prices with agents for eVisa:

Approximate prices with agents for eVisa:

- 1 hour: \$100 | 3 Hours: \$80 | 8 Hours (1 Day): \$70
- 2 Days: \$65 | 3 Days: \$60 | 4 Days: \$50

Bus Visa Run is usually around \$150 (3,9m VND), and the trip is around 12–15 hours. You leave Da Nang i~6–7 am on a comfy bus with legroom, go to Laos to get the new 90-day eVisa, and return ~8–10 pm. The most popular visa agency in Da Nang is [Lynn Visa](#). Passport photo studio [here](#).

Alternatively, you can apply for an eVisa through the [government website](#) for around \$25 (they can be very strict with the applications, though, we know people with rejected eVisa applications and lost flights because of minor mistakes during the application process).

Plan B: You fly to Kuala Lumpur or Bangkok (cheapest flights usually) and do the regular or express process while you are there, some agencies can issue the visa in a few hours at a higher rate, too.

 **Important:** Please note that February is usually Tet (New Year) in Vietnam, and many services, including the immigration, are closed. If you plan to come to Da Nang in February, ensure you complete the eVisa process "before" the Tet holidays.. Many cafes and restaurants are also closed during Tet, overpriced, or understaffed with various delays in orders and other services.

Transportation (Within the City Trips, including Airport)

✗ Avoid random taxi drivers outside the airport and around the city (even if they wear Grab jackets and helmets as some of them may be scammers)

✓ Always order [Grab](#) or other local taxi apps like [Xanh SM](#), [Maxim](#), and [InDrive](#) (The airport has a Grab Station a few meters outside the exit and the pricing is usually around \$5 till My An, the area that most nomads stay)

Transportation (Long-Distance Trips)

✗ Grab for long distances: **\$15–50 per trip**

✓ Local taxi companies: **\$1–6 per trip** (depends on the car and pax)

✓ InDrive can also be a good option for long distance (i.e., Da Nang – Hoi An/BaNa Hills/Hue)

💰 **Savings:** \$14–44 per trip

🕒 **Time saved:** 5–10m per ride (You can prebook 4–7 seater cars or 16-seater minivans)

✓ Da Nang – Hoi An Tourist Car Service: +84 70 599 9007 (WhatsApp) / 0705999007 (Zalo)

🚗 4-seater car: 250,000 VND | 🚗 7-seater car: 300,000 VND | 🚗 16-seater car: 400,000 VND

🚗 Pick-up at Da Nang Airport, train station, or city center for travel to Hoi An or vice versa

🚗 Shuttle service to attractions such as Ba Na Hills, Thanh Tai Mountain, Linh Ung Pagoda, Ngu Hanh Son (Marble Mountains), Hue City, etc.

The pricing may change so always ask the company for pricing confirmation/updates.

Pro Tip: Take the morning "tourist" train if you plan to visit Hue, fantastic sea views (come back to Da Nang by taxi company or the local train)

ATM Withdrawals & QR Payments

✗ Standard ATMs: **220,000 VND (~\$9) per withdrawal**

✓ VP Bank ATMs: **0 VND** (TP Bank was the same but they started charging, things may change).

💰 **Savings:** \$9–180/month, as some ATMs allow up 2m vnd (\$76) withdrawal only

🕒 **Time saved:** 1–2 hours/month

Pro Tip: There are also apps that you can pay with your phone to QR codes on local stores, such as local grocery stores, cafes, restaurants, food market, street vendors, etc. (we will mention a few soon). Most of the international and tourist businesses accept cards such as Visa and Mastercard.

Many people open a **Timo Bank** account with tourist visa, passport, VN phone number, and address to pay through the app on local QR codes. (The office is on the other side of the Golden Bridge). Please note that your account will freeze every time the eVisa expires and you will need to go to the bank for 5 minutes with the new eVisa so they can update your details and unfreeze the account.

This will allow you to transfer money from a foreign bank account to your Vietnamese bank account so you can pay to local QR codes through the bank. Revolut for example usually charges just around 1–2\$ transaction fee. You cannot transfer money from the Vietnamese bank account to a foreign bank and you cannot get a card for ATMs on a tourist visa.

You can do the same with Sacombank, Vietcom Bank, and a few more.

You can use **Yodl Pay** to pay with stablecoins to local QR codes. Scan the merchant QR, pay in crypto, the merchant receives VND automatically.

The owners of this app will be at the Nomad Fest so you can meet them and ask any questions you may have. **Yodl Pay will also offer 2 evening networking events during the Nomad Fest (21 & 23 March 2026) with free credits so you can buy a few drinks by using their app.** (You can use the referral code E3RG5K at **Yodl Pay** when you create an account)

If you use a foreign bank card to pay somewhere, the shop may charge you 3–5% more in the total bill (it depends on the cafe, restaurant, etc.).

Motorbike Rental

You can rent a motorbike starting from around \$40-50/month for a simple one.

Renting a simple electric bike can be more expensive but it is safer than renting a regular motorbike as you need to have insurance and the right driving license for Vietnam (most people don't have the right documents so they may get a fine if police stops them to check their papers).

We suggest using Grab motorbikes to move around as they are affordable, fast, clean, and you don't need to worry about the legal driving documents.

Pro Tip: Order Grab with WiFi from the Airport and buy a sim at a local official Viettel store in My An as the stores at the airport ask for more money. Vinaphone sims work well in Da Nang, too.

ORIGINAL PASSPORT is required for SIM registration (copy/ photo passport is not accepted)

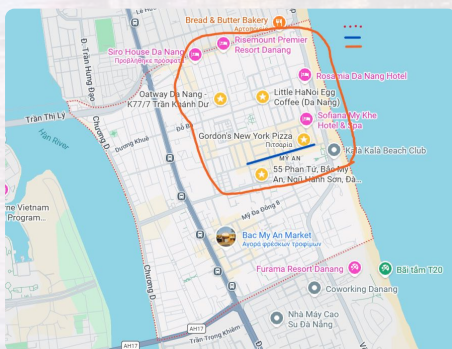

Most nomads stay in **My An area (around the An Thuong streets)**, as many coworking spaces, laptop-friendly cafes, international restaurants, and various community activities, are there.

Others stay in **Son Tra area (close to My An or the Dragon Bridge)**, and others a bit further like 10+ minutes away by motorbike from My An, as you can find way better and more affordable apartments (i.e., FPT Complex, Riverside, Son Tra area between the Dragon Bridge and Lady Buddha)

Where Digital Nomads Stay

Finding Your Perfect Base

Choosing where to stay depends entirely on how long you're planning to be in Da Nang. For 3 months or more, renting an apartment offers the best value and most authentic experience. You'll have your own kitchen, workspace, and the freedom to truly make Da Nang your home. (1-2 months is also possible in higher rates)

The favorite neighborhood among nomads is **An Thuong**. This beachfront area perfectly balances work and play; you're steps from coworking spaces, surrounded by nomad-friendly cafés, yet just a short walk from My Khe beach. The neighborhood has become a mini nomad village where you'll constantly bump into familiar faces at coffee shops and community events.

For shorter stays of just days or weeks; hostels, hotels, and Airbnb in the An Thuong area is the way to go.

How to book an apartment, if you visit Da Nang for 1-6 months

It's possible to book an apartment even for a month, you just need your passport and the tourist visa. Please note that they will ask for an extra month deposit and you'll get it back after leaving the apartment in the same condition as you found it. You will need to sign a contract with all the rental terms, translated in English and Vietnamese, and you will keep a copy.

⚠ Attention: Ensure that there is a term that the landlord is responsible for any repairs caused naturally to the apartment or devices such as kitchen, fridge, washing machine, AC, TV Screen, etc.

If you need an apartment, we suggest following these steps:

- Book a hotel for 2-3 nights in the area you want to find an apartment
- Share your requirements, 2-3 days before coming to Da Nang, on a Facebook group like [this](#) one (Vietnamese FB & Zalo groups have better deals, though)
- Schedule visits to the apartments during the 2-3 days you booked your hotel
- Walk around the city and ask local business owners and residents for available apartments, you may find great deals that way)
- Important: the owners usually give the apartment to the ones who pay first

- High-floor with windows for sunlight

Recommended Activities and Attractions for people who visit Da Nang for a few days

- **Marble Mountains** (Visit the big cave at Gate B and take ticket for the lift and the temples), head to **Hoi An Ricefields** (i.e., Roving Chillhouse for lunch), and then **Memories Land** (minishows 5-7 pm and Hoi An Memories Show 8-9 pm)
- **Lady Buddha** exploration (monkeys and temples) and **Ca Chuon Space** for relaxing beach vibes or **Tien Sa Beach (Simple Beach Bar)** for more party beach vibes or **Bounce Beach Bar** for more family/couple/relaxing vibes with a pool)
- **Han Market & Bac My An Market** for shopping (AO DAI, souvenirs, snacks, luggage, clothes, and more)
- **Han River Walk** (A: The View - Yacht Restaurant to Dragon Bridge & Night Market: ~10' walk), and (B: Đường hoa Bạch Đằng to BẾN DU THUYỀN PHN ĐÀ NẴNG: ~17' walk) - Around 40' walk if you walk on Dragon Bridge, too. The **Dragon Bridge** also throws fire & water for 5-10' at 9 pm every Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and some extra special days
- **Ba Na Hills & Golden Bridge** with **World Guinness Record Cable Car**, the **French Village** and the gardens, castles, temples, fun parks, and more (Full day trip, take a taxi to go and come back, the cable car stops around 10 pm, it's every 30' after 6 pm, ask there for more information). We strongly recommend buying the ticket with the lunch buffet option ~1.3m VND, it includes a huge all you can eat buffet.
- **Nui Than Tai- Hot Springs Park** is a popular eco-tourism resort located in the Hoa Vang District of Da Nang. It is famous for its natural mineral hot springs, massive water park, and relaxing mud baths.
- **Mikazuki Water Park 365** is Vietnam's first 365-day indoor hot water park, located inside the Da Nang Mikazuki Japanese Resorts & Spa. Spanning 10,000 square meters, this Japanese-style entertainment complex features massive indoor and outdoor pools, thrilling slides, and authentic health experiences.
- **Coconut Boat Ride & Hoi An Ancient Town** (take AO DAI clothes with you if you want to take some nice photos in Hoi An)
- **Teh Dar Show** in Hoi An (local Vietnamese tribe event with acrobatics show)
- **The Heritage Show** in Da Nang (Interactive Vietnamese dancing performance)
- **My Son Sanctuary** (they usually do a traditional show, check the times for that)
- **Hue**: Go by tourist train in the morning and come back in the evening or the next day by taxi or the local train (Visit the Imperial Citadel, the Yellow Palace, the Emperor Tomb, the Abandoned Dragon Waterpark, Bar Street in the evening, and ensure you taste the traditional Hue cuisine)
- **Cham Islands** (daytrip from Hoi An with a boat, there is a kind of a beautiful secret beach, some temples, the village, and snorkeling area with corals). Just ensure the weather is great to fully enjoy the trip.
- **Bach Ma National Park** (a nice hiking trip to this park full of nature, nice views, and a waterfall)
- **Lang Co Beach** (it's closer to Hue with floating restaurants on the beach)
- Da Nang also has many **camping** sites on the west side with tents, bungalows, glamping, etc.

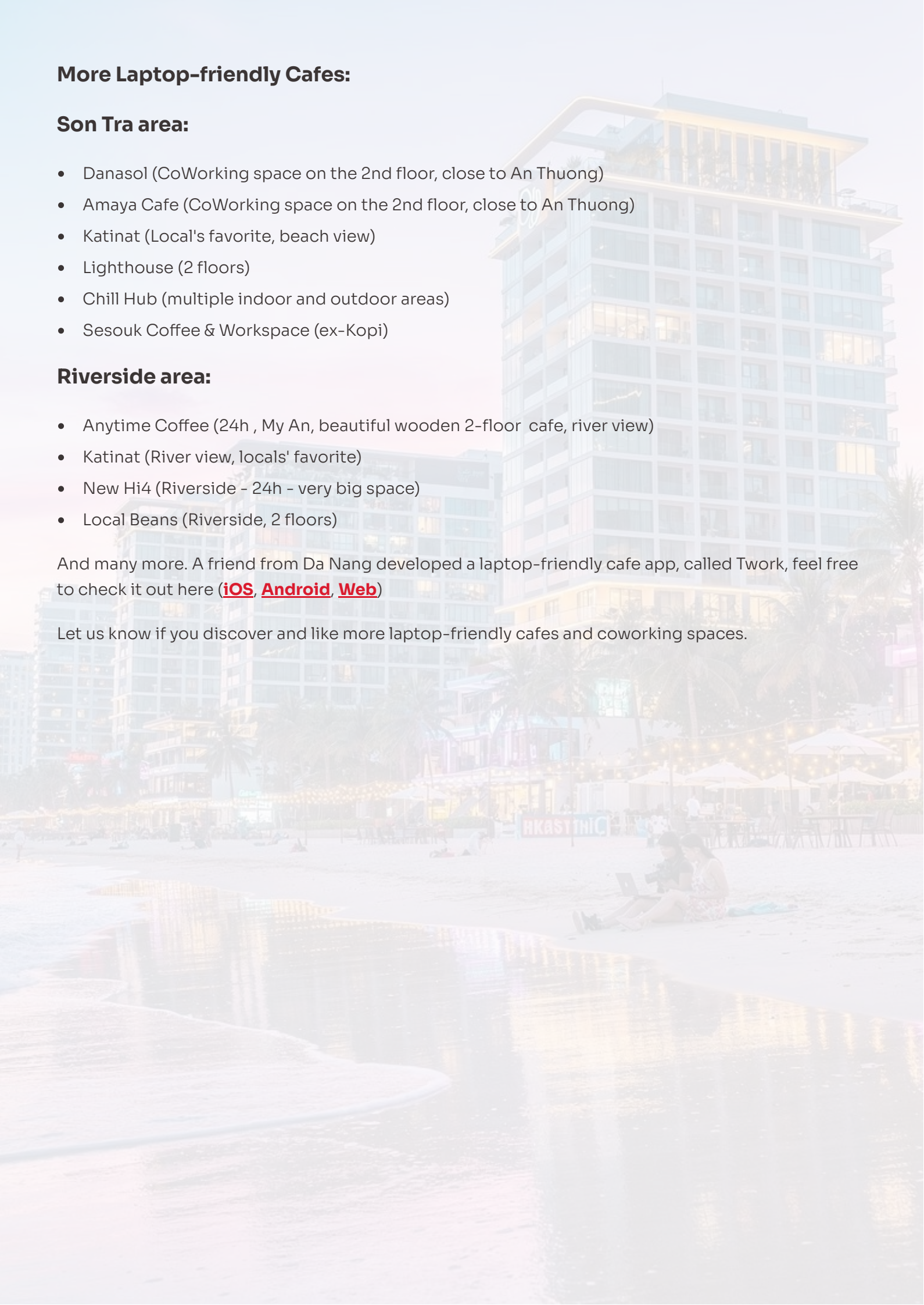

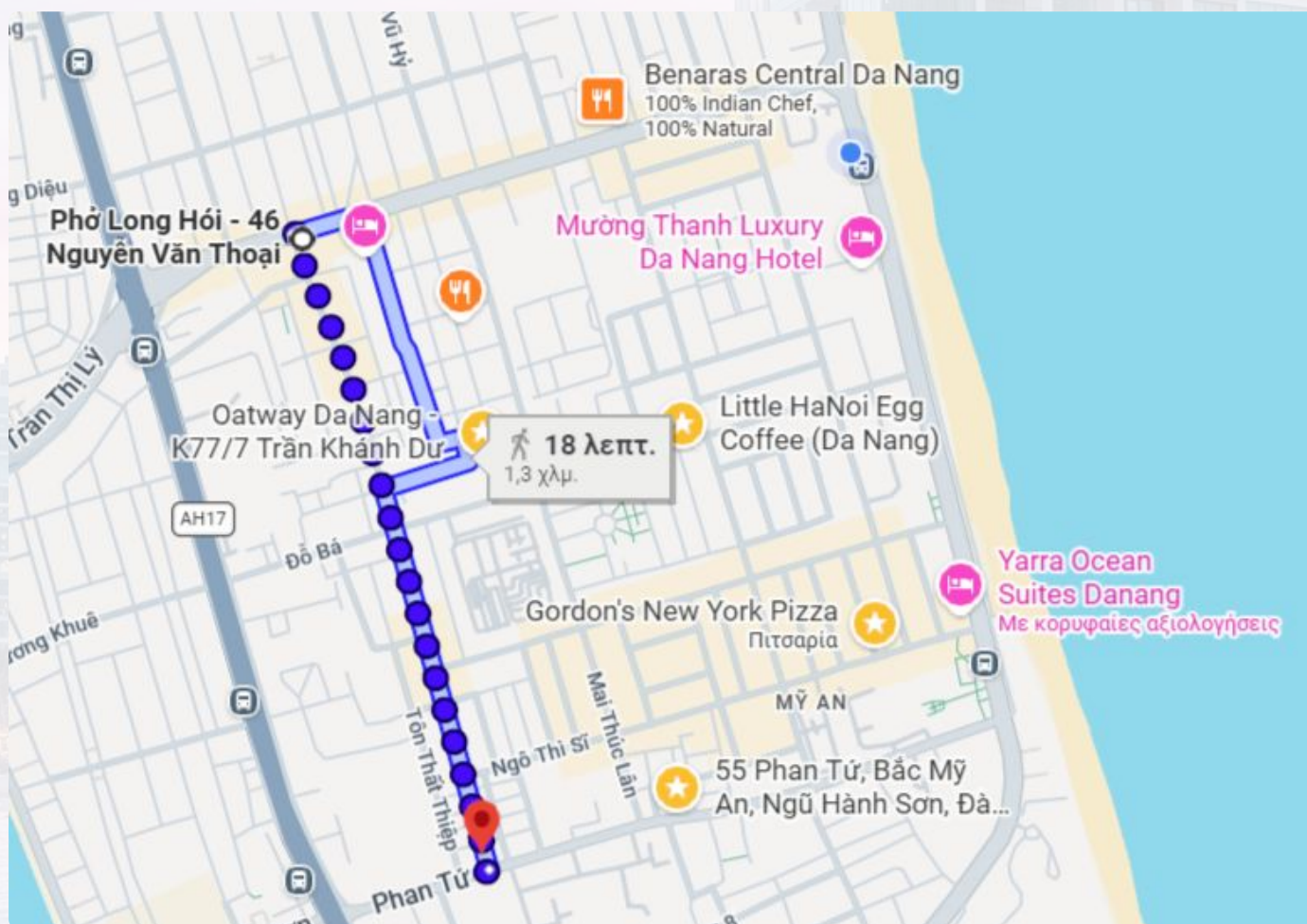

An Thuong represents roughly **0.02%–0.04%** of Da Nang's total land area. Yes, Da Nang is a big city with many different areas, it's not only An Thuong. The other side of the airport has beautiful lakes with green mountains and camping/glamping sites for example. That's around 30-40 minutes away from An Thuong by motorbike.

Cost of Living in Da Nang

One of Da Nang's biggest draws is its remarkably affordable cost of living without sacrificing quality. You can maintain a comfortable lifestyle, dine at excellent restaurants, and enjoy regular social activities; all while spending significantly less than you would in Western cities or even other popular nomad destinations. Here's a realistic breakdown of monthly expenses to help you budget effectively.



Accommodation

Studio: \$150–250 USD

1BR: \$350–450 USD

2BR: \$500–1000 USD



Pro tip: Other areas like Son Tra, FPT Complex, Downtown, or near the Airport and Marble Mountains can be up to 50% cheaper!



Food & Dining

Local meals: \$1–2 USD

International restaurants:
\$2–7 USD

Cooking at home: It can be as low as \$0.20–0.55 USD per meal

Food markets like bac My An Market near An Thuong, offer incredible produce at unbeatable prices, cooking at home is both delicious and economical.



Coworking & Work

Many spaces offer half/full day or week passes if you prefer flexibility, and the café work culture is strong; most coffee shops welcome laptop workers with fast WiFi and electricity plugs.

Motorbike rental: \$40–55 USD/month (~1–1.4 million VND)

Gas: \$5–17 USD/month (~130,000–430,000 VND)

Grab rides: \$0.50–3 USD per trip for short distance inside the city (~12,000–75,000 VND)

SIM card (Viettel): \$4–7 USD/month (~100,000–175,000 VND)

\$7 for example, includes 6GB + 100 minutes per day; more than enough for most nomads

Health insurance: \$35–40 USD/month (~900,000–1,000,000 VND)

Gym: \$22–38 USD/month (~550,000–950,000 VND)

Pickleball (8 sessions): \$10–12 USD/month (~250,000–300,000 VND)

Cinema: \$2–6 USD per ticket (~50,000–150,000 VND)

Most spaces host regular events, workshops, and social gatherings that make networking feel natural rather than forced.
